6.0.0.1 maintenance release fixes some problems with initial v6.0

I have ShopSite v6.0 and am experiencing some technical problems, are there any patches or new releases available?

ShopSite, Inc. sent the following in an email to the ShopSite Tech Bulletin email list on March 15th 2002 which announces the release of ShopSite v6.0.0.1 and lists the fixes made since the initial v6.0 release:

FIXES INCLUDED IN V6.0.0.1

The following 6.0 problems have been resolved in v6.0.0.1

Payment Processors (VeriSign and Authorize.Net)

- * Merchants had to go into ShopSite's Authorize.Net configuration screen and save the settings in order for the placing or billing of orders to work using Authorize.Net
- * Merchants had to use the payment gateway's virtual terminal interface to bill any orders that were placed before upgrading to 6.0. You could not bill these orders from within ShopSite. In addition billing any VeriSign order via ShopSite's interface would not work until going into ShopSite's VeriSign configuration screen and saving the settings.

- * The address verification service (AVS) was not completely working. In 6.0 AVS was a new feature for Authorize.Net, and for VeriSign it now also sends the street address as well as the zip.

Orders

- * QuickBooks limits product names to 31 characters. If names are longer QuickBooks import may fail. ShopSite now truncates product names in the QB download file to 31 characters.
- * When listing orders the "*" character (indicating a new order) was not showing up on new orders if CyberCash was used.

Search Feature

- * On some platforms an empty stoplist would caused publish to fail.
- * On some platforms words could not be manually added to the stoplist.
- * Add to cart image on search results page had a border.
- * If a word contained the "/" character it would not be found.

Shopping Cart and Checkout screens

- * HTML tags in some merchant customizable Store Text could cause JavaScript errors on the Checkout screen.
- * HTML tags in "Use separate Shipping address" text caused duplicate text to be displayed on the Checkout screen.

Miscellaneous

- * In Custom Templates "IF" was only true if the value of the field was "checked". "IF" is now true if there is any value in the field and only false if the field is empty.
- * If no text or image was specified for the order or checkout button in version 4.x, when upgraded to 6.x a broken image would appear.
- * Add to Cart image could have had a border when one was not desired.

The above issues are all resolved in v6.0.0.1
